Rink Management Services has partnered with EDENS to bring back the outdoor roller-skating rink to the Mosaic District. The goal of this event is to create a fun activity that brings the community outside and active after a couple years of Covid-19 quarantine. We plan to run this event from June 24th through September 25th. The setup and take down for this event will be approximately 1 week each. We are requesting that this permit be approved for future years as well. The intention would be to run this roller rink for approximately 90 days each year from the beginning of April through the end of June. We would also like to run an ice rink for approximately 120 day time period opening in early November and closing in late February.

The Skating rink will be open 7 days a week with one hour skating sessions and a fifteen minute “clean up/switch over” break in between each session. Our skating sessions are capped at 50 skaters per session. We will have between 2-5 employees working at any one time. Tickets are sold online and onsite, subject to availability. The operating hours are as follows:

Sunday: 9:45am – 8:45pm

Monday – Thursday: 4pm – 10pm

Friday: 4m – 11:15pm

Saturday: 11am – 11:15pm

The roller-skating rink will be located on Mosaic Town Ctr Dr., at the corner of District Ave. This section of Mosaic Town Ctr Dr. is closed during the length of the event. Guests and employees will be able to park in the available street parking and garage parking at the Mosaic District. Workers and skaters can walk to the roller-skating rink from all parking areas. There are three public restrooms at the Mosaic District, one is located under the Target and two are in the Custom Ink lobby. We have trash cans located inside the rink area that are emptied regularly by the Mosaic District Maintenance team. The Mosaic District has 24/7 security and while the roller-skating rink is here the security will be keeping an eye on it as part of their daily duties.

As part of the roller-skating rink operations, we will be utilizing (2) seven foot by seven foot sheds to serve as sales and skate rental booths. The roller-skating rink will be sitting on top of a Biljax stage in order to level the surface. The roller-skating surface will be 32 ft x 76 ft. The stage will be 32 ft by 76 ft with railings around the outside. There will be market lights strung from ten foot poles around

the border of the rink. There will also be 6 speakers mounted on the poles, with the speakers facing towards the inside of the rink. There are no rides, games, food vendors or animals as part of the roller-skating rink.
